ela als de	Summary/Purpose: Allows insurers or agents to disclose to the Department of mergency Management certain information obtained from policyholders or others regarding aims or reports of property damage resulting from a natural disaster. Such information may so be given to other state, federal, or local government officials. The information may not entify the names or addresses of the persons whose property is damaged and may only include gregated data that relates to the assessment of the damage.
