5. Summary/Purpose:

This bill prohibits local school boards, in the exercise of their authority to protect the well-being of students as recognized by federal law pursuant to 20 U.S.C. § 4071 (f) that provide equal access and fair opportunity to use school facilities or to distribute literature, from allowing such access or opportunity to use such school facilities or to distribute literature to any club or other group that is focused on supporting, assisting, or justifying any lifestyle involving sexual behavior.
