This bill provides that local school boards, in the exercise of their authority to protect the well being of students as recognized by federal law pursuant to 20 U.S.C. § 4071 (f), may prohibit school facilities from being used by any student club or other student group that encourages or promotes sexual activity by unmarried minor students.
