5.	Summary/Purpose: The bill would change membership of the Ohio River Valley Water Sanitation Commission. Currently, all three Virginia members of the Commission are members of the State Water Control Board. Under the provisions of the bill, two of the commissioners would be members of the State Water Control Board and the third would be the Director of the Department of Environmental Quality. The bill also would provide that any member of the Commission who cannot be present at a meeting of the Commission, or at any committee or subcommittee of the Commission, may designate any employee of the Department of Environmental Quality or a member of the State Water Control Board to attend the meeting and vote on his behalf. The bill also would repeal a statutory provision authorizing the executive secretary of the State Water Control Board, or his designated representative, to vote at any meeting of the Commission unless all the Virginia commissioners were present and voting.
