**4. Title**            Schools to provide information to noncustodial parents.

**5. Summary/Purpose:** This bill requires that, unless a court order has been issued to the contrary, the noncustodial parent of a student enrolled in any public or private elementary, middle, or high school or day care center must be provided the full and complete information concerning the child's school or day care activities, scholastic record, test results, academic achievement and progress, and school behavior in the same manner and form as is provided to the custodial parent by the public or private elementary, middle, or high school or day care center.

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal implications:** This bill may have a fiscal impact at the local level since noncustodial parents would need to be notified of a child's progress. Local school divisions may incur additional costs, depending on how this notification is provided. The impact cannot be quantified.
