suf if t res	<b>Summary/Purpose:</b> Allows a juvenile to file a petition on his own behalf if he alleges fficient facts to invoke the jurisdiction of the juvenile and domestic relations district court and the petition is authorized by an intake officer. The intake officer may proceed informally to solve the matter or may permit the juvenile to file a petition. If a petition is filed, the court ast appoint a guardian ad litem to represent the juvenile.
