- 3. Committee Education and Health
- **4. Title** Board of Education; annual salary.
- **5. Summary/Purpose:** This bill institutes annual salaries of \$6,000 for members of the Board of Education and \$9,000 for the Board president, effective July 1, 2006. Members will no longer receive the \$50 per diem currently authorized by § 2.2-2813, but will continue to receive reimbursement for expenses incurred in the performance of duties.
- 6. Fiscal Impact (See #8.)
- 7. Budget amendment necessary: No. The bill is effective July 1, 2006.
- 8. Fiscal implications: There would be no administrative cost on the Department of Education to carry out the requirements of the provision. Funding is already included in the department's budget for the per diem plus expenses for each Board member. Additional funds would need to be provided to cover the salary costs. This additional funding would not be needed until the 2006-2008 biennium. The net cost would be approximately \$56,516 annually.
- 9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Board of Education.
- **10. Technical amendment necessary:** No.
- **11. Other comments:** Part-time members of the Parole Board, the Chair of the Compensation Board, and the members of the Virginia Retirement System Board are salaried.
