4. Title Martin Luther King, Jr. Living History and Public Policy Center Board of Trustees.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Amends the membership of the Board of Trustees for the Martin Luther King, Jr. Living History and Public Policy Center to provide for one representative of the named institutions of higher education upon the recommendation of the president, to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules and the Speaker of the House of Delegates. Reappointment to the Board is contingent upon members attending at least one-half of the Board meetings during their current term of service. In addition, the provision pertaining to the initial hiring of certain employees by the Board has been removed in order that the Board's authority may be consistent with similar nonprofit, federal tax-exempt organizations.
