**3. Committee:** Passed both houses

**4. Title:** Auditor of Public Accounts; maintenance of database containing historical information.

**5. Summary/Purpose:** This bill requires the Auditor of Public Accounts, with aid from the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission (JLARC) to establish and maintain a searchable database on its website. The Internet site is to contain at least 18 different types of state related data ranging from expenditures and revenues to demographic information for the 10 most recently ended fiscal years of the Commonwealth. The online database is to be made available to citizens of the Commonwealth to allow public access to historical revenue collections and appropriations with related demographic information.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are:** Minimal

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal implications:** The Auditor of Public Accounts indicates there will be minimal to no fiscal impact to the agency. JLARC currently collects much of the required already; they expect no fiscal impact to their agency. All system and staffing requirements are to be met using existing resources.

**9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** Auditor of Public Accounts, Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission.
