5. Summary/Purpose: The bill prohibits an employee from seeking any further relief for discharge or discrimination as a result of reporting health or safety violations if the employee does not file his complaint alleging such discharge or discrimination within 60 days after it occurs.

6. Fiscal impact: The bill does not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Labor and Industry.
