5. Summary/Purpose:

Provides for delivery of resumes and statements of economic interests for gubernatorial appointees by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to the two Committees on Privileges and Elections and for a joint subcommittee of the two Committees to review those papers. This bill is a recommendation of the Joint Subcommittee to Study the Appropriate Balance of Power between the Legislative and Executive Branches to Support a Two-Term Governor in the Commonwealth (HJR 13, 2004).
