CHAPTER 15

An Act to amend and reenact § 6 of Chapter 3, as amended, of Chapter 99 of the Acts of Assembly of 1940, which provided a charter for the Town of Iron Gate, relating to chief of police.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 6 of Chapter 3, as amended, of Chapter 99 of the Acts of Assembly of 1940 is amended and reenacted as follows:

TOWN SERGEANT CHIEF OF POLICE

§ 6. The town council may, by a majority vote, appoint a ~~town sergeant~~ *chief of police*. The ~~town sergeant~~ *chief of police* shall qualify by taking the oath prescribed by the Code of Virginia and give bond in such amount as the council may require. He shall be vested with powers of a conservator of the peace, and shall have the same powers and discharge the same duties as a constable within the corporate limits of the town and to a distance of one mile beyond the same, and shall perform such other duties as may be from time to time prescribed by the council.
