## **CHAPTER 161**

An Act to amend and reenact § 22.1-202.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to comparative religion as an elective course.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 22.1-202.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 22.1-202.1. Comparative religion as elective course. <u>Local school boards</u> The Board of Education shall authorize local school boards to offer, as an elective in grades nine through 12 with appropriate credits toward graduation, a comparative religion class that focuses on the basic tenets, history, and religious observances and rites of world religions.
