## **CHAPTER 676**

An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 18.2-374.1:2, relating to sexually explicit items involving children; penalty.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

- 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-374.1:2 as follows: § 18.2-374.1:2. Facilitating payment for access to certain sexually explicit visual material; penalty. Any person who intentionally operates an Internet website for the purpose of facilitating the payment for access to sexually explicit visual material that utilizes or has as a subject a person under the age of 18 years is guilty of a Class 4 felony.
- 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
