A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-865.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to causing the death of another while engaging in a race; penalty.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That $\S$ 46.2-865.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
§ 46.2-865.1. Injuring another or causing the death of another while engaging in a race; penalties.
$A$. Any person who, while engaging in a race in violation of $\S 46.2-865$ in a manner so gross, wanton and culpable as to show a reckless disregard for human life-::
2. eauses Causes serious bodily injury to another person who is not involved in the violation of § 46.2-865 is guilty of a Class 6 felony; or
3. Causes the death of another person who is not involved in the violation of §46.2-865 is guilty of aggravated involuntary manslaughter, a felony punishable by a term of imprisonment of not less than one nor more than 20 years, one year of which shall be a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment.
B. Upon conviction, the court shall suspend the driver's license of such person for a period of not less than one year nor more than three years, [ the suspension of which shall commence upon the person's release from incarceration, if any, and the court and ] shall order the surrender of the license to be disposed of in accordance with the provisions of § 46.2-398.
4. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or commitment. Pursuant to $\S \mathbf{3 0 - 1 9 . 1}: 4$, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is $\$ 0$ for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
