AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
(Proposed by the Senate Committee for Courts of Justice
on March 6, 2006)
(Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Reid)
A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-204.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to fraudulent use of birth
certificate, etc., penalties.
Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
1. That § 18.2-204.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
§ 18.2-204.1. Fraudulent use of birth certificates, etc.; penalty.
A. It shall be unlawful for any person to obtain, possess, sell, or transfer the birth certificate of
another for the purpose of establishing a false identity for himself or for another person.
B. It shall be unlawful for any person to obtain, possess, sell, or transfer any document for the
purpose of establishing a false status, occupation, membership, license or identity for himself or any
other person.
C. Any person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor, except
when the birth certificate or document is obtained, possessed, sold, or transferred with the intent to use
such certificate or document to purchase a firearm, in which case a violation of this section shall be
punishable as a Class 6 felony.
D. The provisions of this section shall not apply to members of state, federal, county, city or town
law-enforcement agencies in the performance of their duties.
E. The provisions of this section shall not preclude prosecution under any other statute.
