6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 30-19.12 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**8 § 30-19.12. Compensation of members of the General Assembly and certain commissions engaged in
9 legislative services.

10 A. Subject to the provisions of subsections B through E G hereof, members of all legislative
11 committees, legislative commissions, and councils established by the General Assembly and all
12 committees and subcommittees of any of the foregoing shall receive compensation at such rate as
13 provided for in § 2.2-2813. Any other member of the General Assembly whose attendance, in the
14 opinion of the chairman of such a group, is required at a sitting of such group shall also be entitled to
15 compensation at the same rate.

16 ~~B. Legislative members~~ A legislative member shall not be entitled to compensation pursuant to this
17 section for any services performed on any day that the ~~General Assembly~~ member's house is in active
18 session. For purposes of this subsection, "active session" means (i) any day during any regular session
19 of the General Assembly or the first extension thereof, (ii) any day that a roll call vote is taken in the
20 member's house during any second or subsequent extension of a regular session that is not a pro forma
21 session, or (iii) any day that a roll call vote is taken in the member's house during any special session
22 of the General Assembly that is not a pro forma session.

23 C. A legislative member shall not be entitled to compensation pursuant to this section for legislative
24 services performed on Capitol Square on any day that the member's house has a pro forma session.

25 D. Full-time employees of the Commonwealth or of any of its political subdivisions shall not be
26 entitled to compensation pursuant to this section.

27 ~~D~~ E. No person shall receive pursuant to this section a total of more than one day's compensation for
28 services performed on any one day. Whenever a member attends two or more meetings for which
29 compensation is authorized herein in a single day, such one day's compensation shall be prorated from
30 among the activities served.

31 ~~E~~ F. Compensation of members of the General Assembly provided for in this section shall be paid
32 by the offices of the Clerk of the House of Delegates or Clerk of the Senate as appropriate and funds
33 therefor transferred from the appropriate activity.

34 G. For purposes of this section, "Capitol Square" means the grounds and all buildings in the City of
35 Richmond bounded by Bank, Governor, Broad and Ninth Streets. "Pro forma session" means a session
36 that is announced as a pro forma session by the presiding officer and in which no business is scheduled
37 to be conducted.
