9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 29.1-742 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 29.1-742. Towing water skis, surfboards, etc.
13	A. No person shall operate a vessel on any waters of the Commonwealth for towing a person or
14	persons on water skis, a surfboard, an inflatable tube, or a similar device unless (i) there is in the vessel
15	a person, in addition to the operator, in a position to observe the progress of the person or persons being
16	towed or unless and (ii) the skier or skiers wear life preservers a U.S. Coast Guard approved personal
17	flotation device.
18	B. No person shall operate a vessel on any water of the Commonwealth towing a person or persons
19	on water skis, a surfboard, an inflatable tube or a similar device, nor shall any person engage in water
20	skiing or a similar activity at any time between the hours from one-half hour after sunset to one-half
21 22	hour before sunrise. The provisions of this subsection shall not constitute a defense to any provision of § 29.1-738.
$\frac{12}{23}$	C. The provisions of subsections A and B of this section do not apply to a performer engaged in a
23 24	professional exhibition.
25	D. No person shall operate or manipulate any vessel, towrope, or other device by which the direction
26	or location of water skis, a surfboard, an inflatable tube or a similar device may be affected or
27	controlled in such a way as to cause the water skis, surfboard, <i>inflatable tube</i> or similar device, or any
28	person upon the device to collide with any object or person.
