10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 64.1-132.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 64.1-132.2. Collection of personal property by affidavit.
13	A. Sixty days after the death of a decedent, any person indebted to the decedent or having possession
14	of tangible personal property or an instrument evidencing a debt, obligation, stock or chose in action
15	belonging to the decedent may make payment of the indebtedness or deliver the tangible personal
16	property or an instrument evidencing a debt, obligation, stock or chose in action to a person claiming to
17	be the successor of the decedent upon being presented an affidavit made by or on behalf of the
18	successor stating that:
19	1. The value of the entire personal probate estate, wherever located, does not exceed \$15,000
20 21	\$50,000;
22	2. At least sixty 60 days have elapsed since the death of the decedent;
22	3. No application for the appointment of a personal representative is pending or has been granted in any jurisdiction;
23 24	4. The will, if any, was duly probated and the list of heirs required by § 64.1-134 was duly filed;
25	and
26	5. The claiming successor is entitled to payment or delivery of the property, and the basis upon
27	which such entitlement is claimed.
28	B. A transfer agent of any security shall change the registered ownership on the books of a
29	corporation from the decedent to the successor upon the presentation of an affidavit as provided in
30	subsection A.
