6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 15.2-1127 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 15.2-1127. Vacant building registration; penalty.

9 *The Town of Pulaski, in a conservation and rehabilitation district of the town, and Any any city, by*
10 *ordinance, may require the owner or owners of buildings that have been vacant for a continuous period*
11 *of twelve 12 months or more to register such buildings on an annual basis and may impose an annual*
12 *registration fee not to exceed twenty-five dollars \$25 to defray the cost of processing such registration.*
13 *The registration of buildings shall be on forms designated by the city locality and filed with the agency*
14 *designated by the city locality. Failure to register shall be a fifty-dollar \$50 civil penalty; however,*
15 *failure to register in conservation and rehabilitation districts designated by the governing body, or in*
16 *other areas designated as blighted pursuant to § 36-49.1:1, shall be punishable by a civil penalty not*
17 *exceeding \$250. Notice shall be mailed to the owner or owners, at the address to which property tax*
18 *notices are sent, at least 30 days prior to the assessment of the civil penalty.*
