14	welfare agencies shall undergo an emergency preparedness training program as described in this

16	develop such a program, which shall include the essential procedures, operations, and assignments
17	required to prevent, manage, and respond to a critical event or emergency, including natural disasters
18	involving fire, flood, tornadoes, or other severe weather; loss or disruption of power, water,

	communications, or shelter; medical emergencies; explosions; bomb threats; gun, knife, or other
20	weapons threats; spills or exposures to hazardous substances; the presence of unauthorized persons or
