6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 53.1-41 of the Code of Virginia, relating to work programs for child
7	support obligors.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 53.1-41 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 53.1-41. Opportunities for work and career and technical education.
11	To the extent feasible, it shall be the duty of the Director to provide persons sentenced to the
12	Department with opportunities to work and to participate in career and technical education programs as
13	operated by the Department of Correctional Education in accordance with § 22.1-339 et seq. Such work
14	opportunities may include business, industrial, agricultural, highway maintenance and construction, and
15	work release programs as hereafter specified in this article. In addition, prisoners may be employed to
16	improve, repair, work on or cultivate public property or buildings.
17	In addition to meeting the qualifications for work performance and security compatibility, preference
18	for placement in work programs shall be given to any prisoner who requests a work assignment and
19	assigns a minimum of 50% of his earnings to his child support obligation.
