| 10 | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 38 of Title 58.1 an article |
| 11 | numbered 10, consisting of a section numbered 58.1-3851, as follows: |
| 12 | Article 10. |
| 13 | Local Tourism Zone. |
| 14 | § 58.1-3851. Creation of local tourism zones. |
| 15 16 | A. Any city, county, or town may establish, by ordinance, one or more tourism zones. Each locality |
| 16 17 | may grant tax incentives and provide certain regulatory flexibility in a tourism zone. B. The tax incentives may be provided for up to 10 years and may include, but not be limited to (i) |
| 18 | reduction of permit fees, (ii) reduction of user fees, and (iii) reduction of any type of gross receipts tax. |
| 19 | The extent and duration of such incentive proposals shall conform to the requirements of the |
| 20 | Constitutions of Virginia and of the United States. |
| 21 | C. The governing body may also provide for regulatory flexibility in such zone that may include, but |
| 22 | not be limited to (i) special zoning for the district, (ii) permit process reform, (iii) exemption from |
| 23 | ordinances, [excluding ordinances or provisions of ordinances adopted pursuant to the requirements of |
| 24 | the Chesapeake Bay Preservation Act (§ 10.1-2100 et seq.), the Erosion and Sediment Control Law |
| 25 | (§ 10.1-560 et seq.), or the Virginia Stormwater Management Act (§ 10.1-603.1 et seq.),] and (iv) any |
| 26 | other incentive adopted by ordinance, which shall be binding upon the locality for a period of up to 10 |
| 27 | vears. |

28 D. The establishment of a tourism zone shall not preclude the area from also being designated as an enterprise zone.
