6	A BILL to establish a pilot program encouraging law-enforcement officers to learn a second language.

/	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
8	1. § 1. The Harrisonburg City Police Department and the Rockingham County Sheriff's Department
9	shall develop a program to encourage law-enforcement officers employed by those Departments to gain
10	proficiency in a language other than English. Such proficiency may be achieved through enrollment in
11	language classes offered through the Virginia Community College System, distance learning
12	opportunities, or any other available educational resources.
13	§ 2. The Harrisonburg Chief of Police and the Rockingham County Sheriff shall develop guidelines
14	and procedures governing participation and completion of the program, including the establishment of
15	an incentive program for gaining proficiency in a language other than English. The Chief of Police and
16	Sheriff shall identify available resources for learning a second language, including but not limited to
17	enrollment in language classes offered at a community college, distance learning opportunities, or the
18	establishment of any other programs or opportunities.
19	§ 3. Participation in the program shall be limited to a total of 25 officers.
20	2. That the provisions of this act shall expire on January 1, 2009.
