## VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

- 2 An Act to amend and reenact § 2.2-3802 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Government Data 3 Collection and Dissemination Practices Act; applicability.
- Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6 7 1. That § 2.2-3802 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8 § 2.2-3802. Systems to which chapter inapplicable. 9 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to personal information systems: 10 1. Maintained by any court of the Commonwealth; 11
  - 2. Which may exist in publications of general circulation;
- 12 3. Contained in the Criminal Justice Information System as defined in §§ 9.1-126 through 9.1-137;
- 13 4. Contained in the Virginia Juvenile Justice Information System as defined in §§ 16.1-222 through 16.1-225; 14
- 15 5. Maintained by agencies concerning persons required by law to be licensed in the Commonwealth to engage in the practice of any profession, in which case the names and addresses of persons applying 16 17 for or possessing the license may be disseminated upon written request to a person engaged in the 18 profession or business of offering professional educational materials or courses for the sole purpose of 19 providing the licensees or applicants for licenses with informational materials relating solely to available 20 professional educational materials or courses, provided the disseminating agency is reasonably assured 21 that the use of the information will be so limited;
- 6. Maintained by the Parole Board, the Crime Commission, the Judicial Inquiry and Review 22 23 Commission, the Virginia Racing Commission, and the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control;
- 24 7. Maintained by the Department of State Police; the police department of the Chesapeake Bay 25 Bridge and Tunnel Commission; police departments of cities, counties, and towns; and the campus 26 police departments of public institutions of higher education as established by Chapter 17 (§ 23-232 et 27 seq.) of Title 23, and that deal with investigations and intelligence gathering relating to criminal activity; 28 and maintained by local departments of social services regarding alleged cases of child abuse or neglect 29 while such cases are also subject to an ongoing criminal prosecution; 30
  - 8. Maintained by the Virginia Port Authority as provided in § 62.1-134.1 or 62.1-132.4;
- 31 9. Maintained by the Virginia Tourism Authority in connection with or as a result of the promotion 32 of travel or tourism in the Commonwealth, in which case names and addresses of persons requesting 33 information on those subjects may be disseminated upon written request to a person engaged in the 34 business of providing travel services or distributing travel information, provided the Virginia Tourism 35 Authority is reasonably assured that the use of the information will be so limited;
- 36 10. Maintained by the Division of Consolidated Laboratory Services of the Department of General 37 Services and the Department of Forensic Science, which deal with scientific investigations relating to 38 criminal activity or suspected criminal activity, except to the extent that § 9.1-1104 may apply;
- 39 11. Maintained by the Department of Corrections that deal with investigations and intelligence 40 gathering by persons acting under the provisions of § 53.1-16; and
- 41 12. Maintained by the Department of the State Internal Auditor or internal audit departments of state 42 agencies or institutions that deal with communications and investigations relating to the State Employee 43 Fraud, Waste and Abuse Hotline.

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
