2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 51.5-25.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Statewide Independent*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That § 51.5-25.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 51.5-25.1. Statewide Independent Living Council and Statewide Independent Living Fund created.

9 A. The Statewide Independent Living Council is hereby created to jointly plan with the Department  
10 of Rehabilitative Services activities carried out under Title VII of the federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973  
11 (29 U.S.C. § 796 et seq.) and to provide advice to the Department regarding such activities. Membership  
12 and duties shall be constructed according to federal provisions. The Department of Rehabilitative  
13 Services shall provide staff support for the Council.

14 B. The Council shall have authority to accept gifts, donations, and bequests on behalf of the Council  
15 from any source and to deposit all moneys received in the Statewide Independent Living Fund. The  
16 Council shall submit to the Governor an annual report of all gifts, donations, and bequests accepted;  
17 the names of the donors; and the respective amounts contributed by each donor.

18 C. There is hereby created in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the  
19 Statewide Independent Living Fund (the Fund). The Fund shall be established on the books of the  
20 Comptroller. All moneys appropriated to the fund or received from any source pursuant to subsection B  
21 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to the Fund. Interest earned on moneys in the Fund  
22 shall remain in the Fund and be credited to it. Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including interest  
23 thereon, at the end of each fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in the Fund.  
24 Moneys in the Fund shall be used solely for the purposes of carrying out activities enumerated in the  
25 State Plan for Independent Living, developed pursuant to the Rehabilitation Act. Expenditures and  
26 disbursements from the Fund shall be made by the State Treasurer on warrants issued by the  
27 Comptroller upon written request signed by the Commissioner based upon recommendations from the  
28 Council.
