AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

4 5 6 A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 46.2-1558.1, 46.2-1964.1, 7 46.2-1992.56:1, and 46.2-1993.55:1, relating to alternative print-on-demand program for issuance of temporary license plates to dealers and vehicle owners. 8

9 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 46.2-1558.1, 46.2-1964.1, 10 11 46.2-1992.56:1, and 46.2-1993.55:1 as follows:

§ 46.2-1558.1. Alternative print-on-demand program for issuance of temporary license plates to 12 13 dealers and vehicle owners.

14 A. Notwithstanding the provisions of § 46.2-1558, the Department may develop and implement 15 procedures and requirements necessary for delivery of temporary license plates to dealers and issuance of temporary license plates by dealers to vehicle owners, using print-on-demand technology. 16

17 B. In the event the Department implements a print-on-demand temporary license plate program pursuant to this section, all dealers licensed on or after the effective date of the program shall be 18 required to purchase and issue only print-on-demand temporary license plates. 19

20 C. The Commissioner shall not impose a requirement relating to the minimum number of sets of 21 temporary plates that must be purchased by a dealer pursuant to a print-on-demand temporary license 22 plate program implemented under this section.

D. Except as otherwise provided in this section, temporary license plates delivered and issued 23 24 pursuant to this section shall be subject to all conditions and limitations set forth in this article.

25 § 46.2-1964.1. Alternative print-on-demand program for issuance of temporary license plates to 26 dealers and vehicle owners.

A. Notwithstanding the provisions of § 46.2-1964, the Department may develop and implement 27 28 procedures and requirements necessary for delivery of temporary license plates to dealers and issuance 29 of temporary license plates by dealers to vehicle owners, using print-on-demand technology.

30 B. In the event the Department implements a print-on-demand temporary license plate program 31 pursuant to this section, all dealers licensed on or after the effective date of the program shall be 32 required to purchase and issue only print-on-demand temporary license plates.

33 C. The Commissioner shall not impose a requirement relating to the minimum number of sets of 34 temporary plates that must be purchased by a dealer pursuant to a print-on-demand temporary license 35 plate program implemented under this section.

36 D. Except as otherwise provided in this section, temporary license plates delivered and issued 37 pursuant to this section shall be subject to all conditions and limitations set forth in this article. 38

§ 46.2-1992.56:1. Alternative print-on-demand program for issuance of temporary license plates to dealers and vehicle owners.

A. Notwithstanding the provisions of § 46.2-1992.56, the Department may develop and implement 40 41 procedures and requirements necessary for delivery of temporary license plates to dealers and issuance 42 of temporary license plates by dealers to vehicle owners, using print-on-demand technology.

43 B. In the event the Department implements a print-on-demand temporary license plate program 44 pursuant to this section, all dealers licensed on or after the effective date of the program shall be required to purchase and issue only print-on-demand temporary license plates. 45

C. The Commissioner shall not impose a requirement relating to the minimum number of sets of 46 47 temporary plates that must be purchased by a dealer pursuant to a print-on-demand temporary license **48** plate program implemented under this section.

49 D. Except as otherwise provided in this section, temporary license plates delivered and issued 50 pursuant to this section shall be subject to all conditions and limitations set forth in this article.

51 § 46.2-1993.55:1. Alternative print-on-demand program for issuance of temporary license plates to 52 dealers and vehicle owners.

53 A. Notwithstanding the provisions of § 46.2-1993.55, the Department may develop and implement 54 procedures and requirements necessary for delivery of temporary license plates to dealers and issuance 55 of temporary license plates by dealers to vehicle owners, using print-on-demand technology.

B. In the event the Department implements a print-on-demand temporary license plate program 56 pursuant to this section, all dealers licensed on or after the effective date of the program shall be 57 required to purchase and issue only print-on-demand temporary license plates. 58

59 C. The Commissioner shall not impose a requirement relating to the minimum number of sets of
