10 11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Title 30 a chapter numbered 40, consisting
13	of sections numbered 30-266 through 30-270, as follows:
14	CHAPTER 40.
15 16	§ 30-266. Virginia Budget Office; composition; terms; compensation and expenses; office space; quorum; voting on recommendations.
17	There is hereby created the Virginia Budget Office in the legislative branch of state government. The
18	Office shall consist of nine members of the House of Delegates appointed by the Speaker thereof, of
19	whom at least three shall be members of the House Committee on Appropriations, and five members
20	from the Senate appointed by the Rules Committee of the Senate, of whom at least two shall be members
21 22	of the Senate Committee on Finance, and the Auditor of Public Accounts, who shall serve as a nonvoting ex officio member. Members shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office. Members
$\frac{22}{23}$	may be reappointed for successive terms.
24	Members of the Office shall receive such compensation as provided in § 30-19.12 and shall be
25	reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
26	Funding for the costs of compensation and expenses of the members shall be provided from existing
27 28	appropriations to the Office. Adequate office space shall be provided by the Commonwealth. The Virginia Budget Office shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its membership. A
<b>2</b> 9	majority of the members shall constitute a quorum. Meetings shall be held upon the call of the chairman
30	or whenever the majority of the members so request.
31	No recommendation of the Virginia Budget Office shall be adopted if a majority of the Senate
32 33	members or a majority of the House members appointed to the Commission (i) vote against the recommendation and (ii) vote for the recommendation to fail notwithstanding the majority vote of the
33 34	Virginia Budget Office.
35	§ 30-267. Director, executive staff, and personnel.
36	The Virginia Budget Office shall appoint, subject to confirmation by a majority of the members of
37	the General Assembly, a Director and fix his duties and compensation. The Director may employ and fix
38 39	the duties and compensation of an adequate executive staff as may be requisite to make the studies and research and budget analyses required by this chapter. The Director and executive staff shall be
<b>40</b>	appointed for a term of two years and shall consist of professional persons having experience and
41	training in legislative budgetary procedures, management analyses, and cost accounting. The Director
42	and any executive staff member may be removed from office for cause by a majority vote of the Virginia
43 44	Budget Office. Such other professional personnel, consultants, and secretarial and clerical employees may be engaged upon such terms and conditions as set forth by the Virginia Budget Office.
45	§ 30-268. Powers and duties of the Office.
46	The Office shall have the following powers and duties:
47	A. Prepare fiscal impact statements on legislation introduced in the Virginia General Assembly;
48	B. Investigate the operating efficiencies of all state agencies to ensure that every taxpayer dollar is
49 50	spent efficiently; C. Explore opportunities to privatize, outsource, consolidate, and reorganize various governmental
50 51	functions to operate more efficiently;
52	D. Examine policies and strategies that can be instituted to streamline government programs;
53	E. Undertake any research and analysis which would provide creditable, lower cost alternatives to
54 55	existing or proposed budget programs; and F. Analyze policy proposals offered in other states or elsewhere that have been offered or
55 56	implemented.
57	§ 30-269. State agencies to furnish information and assistance.
58	All agencies of the Commonwealth, their staffs and employees shall provide the Virginia Budget

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Office with necessary information for the performance of its duties and afford the Virginia Budget 59

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Office's staff ample opportunity to observe agency operations. § 30-270. Payment of expenses of Virginia Budget Office. The salaries, per diems, and other expenses necessary to the functions of the Virginia Budget Office shall be payable from funds appropriated to the Virginia Budget Office. 62 63
