6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That § 53.1-223 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 § 53.1-223. Restriction on suits against prisoners.

9 No action or suit on any claim or demand, except suits for divorce, actions to establish a parent and 10 child relationship between a child and a prisoner and actions to establish a prisoner's child support 11 obligation, shall be *instituted maintained* against a prisoner after judgment of conviction and while he is 12 incarcerated, except through his committee, *unless a guardian ad litem is appointed for the prisoner*

13 pursuant to § 8.01-9, or an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth has entered of

14 record an appearance for such prisoner. However, in any suit for divorce instituted against a prisoner,

15 the court shall appoint a committee prior to any determination as to the property of the parties under

16 § 20-107.3.
