1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER 2 An Act to amend and reenact §§ 30-28.16 and 30-34.14 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the duties of 3 certain agencies within the legislative branch of government. 4 [H 886] 5 Approved 6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 7 1. That §§ 30-28.16 and 30-34.14 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: 8 § 30-28.16. Duties of Division and of Director. 9 A. The Division shall: 10 1. Establish a reference library which develops and maintains a library collection to support the work of the Division and the General Assembly and which provides general and specific reference services to 11 12 members of the General Assembly; 2. Keep on file copies of all bills, resolutions, amendments thereto, reports of committees and other 13 14 documents printed by order of either house of the General Assembly; 15 3. Accumulate data and statistics regarding the practical operation and effect of statutes of this and 16 other states; 4. Carry out such research projects as shall be assigned to it by the Committees on Rules of the 17 18 House of Delegates and the Senate; 19 5. Furnish upon written request of any person a copy of any charter of a city or town of the 20 Commonwealth at the charge prevailing from time to time for reproducing same; and 21 6. Carry out research and obtain and analyze information for members of the General Assembly and 22 its committees; and 23 7. Prepare and publish annually, as soon as practicable after January 1, a listing of designated 24 spokespersons or information officers for each department, agency, board, or commission of state 25 government, as shall be designated by the head thereof. Such officers or designated alternatives shall (i) 26 serve as legislative liaison between any such department, agency, board, or commission and the General 27 Assembly, (ii) act as the official spokespersons representing such department, agency, board, or 28 commission, and (iii) be at all times available to assist members of the General Assembly in seeking 29 solutions to problems of citizens of the Commonwealth. 30 B. Upon the request of the Governor, any member of the General Assembly, any Governor's 31 Secretary, or the head of any legislative, judicial or independent agency, the Division shall: 32 1. Draft or aid in drafting legislative bills or resolutions and amendments thereto; 33 2. Advise as to the constitutionality or probable legal effect of proposed legislation; 34 3. Prepare summaries of existing laws affected by proposed legislation, compilations of laws in other states or countries relating to the subject matter of such legislation, and statements of the operation and 35 36 effect of such laws; or 37 4. Make researches and examinations as to any subject of proposed legislation. 38 C. The Director shall perform such other duties as may be required of him by the Committees on 39 Rules of the House of Delegates and the Senate. 40 § 30-34.14. Duties of Division. 41 The Division shall have the following duties: 42 1. Operate an automated data processing center and perform computing and programming services 43 for the House of Delegates, Senate of Virginia, and the Division of Legislative Services. 44 2. To provide technical assistance to the General Assembly of Virginia, and to the agencies which 45 directly serve the General Assembly of Virginia. 3. To represent the interests of the General Assembly in activities involving, obtaining and 46 maintaining data processing services, electronic components, and other related items. 47 48 3A. Prepare and publish annually, as soon as practicable after January 1, a listing of designated spokespersons or information officers for each department, agency, board, or commission of state 49 50 government, as shall be designated by the head thereof. Such officers or designated alternatives shall (i) serve as legislative liaison between any such department, agency, board, or commission and the General 51 Assembly, (ii) act as the official spokesperson representing such department, agency, board, or 52 53 commission, and (iii) be at all times available to assist members of the General Assembly in seeking 54 solutions to problems of citizens of the Commonwealth. 55 4. To perform other duties as directed by the Committees on Rules of the House of Delegates and 56 the Senate of Virginia acting jointly.

any employee of the Division shall reveal any of this property to any person outside of the Division,
except with the consent of the owner of the property.
