Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That § 22.1-3.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8

§ 22.1-3.2. Notice of student's school status required as condition of admission; penalty.

9 A. Prior to admission to any public school of the Commonwealth, a school board shall require the 10 parent, guardian, or other person having control or charge of a child of school age to provide, upon registration, a: 11

12 I. A sworn statement or affirmation indicating whether the student has been expelled from school 13 attendance at a private school or in a public school division of the Commonwealth or in another state for an offense in violation of school board policies relating to weapons, alcohol or drugs, or for the 14 15 willful infliction of injury to another person. This document shall be maintained as a part of the 16 student's scholastic record.

2. A sworn statement or affirmation indicating whether the student has been found guilty of or 17 adjudicated delinquent for any offense listed in subsection G of § 16.1-260 or any substantially similar 18 19 offense under the laws of any state, the District of Columbia, or the United States or its territories. This 20 document shall be maintained as provided in § 22.1-288.2.

21 B. When the child is registered as a result of a foster care placement as defined in § 63.2-100, the 22 information required under this section shall be furnished by the local social services agency or licensed 23 child-placing agency that made the foster care placement.

24 C. Any person making a materially false statement or affirmation shall be guilty upon conviction of a 25 Class 3 misdemeanor. The registration document shall be maintained as a part of the student's scholastic 26 record.
