11 12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-113.1 as follows:
	§ 18.2-113.1. Investment fraud; indictment; penalty.
13	If any person knowingly misuses, disposes of, conceals or misappropriates any money, note, check,
14 15	order, draft, or any other funds or personal property, tangible or intangible, which he receives from another and is entrusted or delivered to him by such person for the purpose of purchasing or operating
15 16	a lawful commercial business, he is guilty of investment fraud. Any person convicted of investment fraud
17	shall be deemed guilty of larceny and may be indicted as for larceny and upon conviction punished as
18	provided in § 18.2-95 or 18.2-96.
19	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
20	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment of
