9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 22.1-341 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 22.1-341. Supervision of Department; composition of Board; terms and vacancies.
13	The Board of the Rehabilitative School Authority is continued and shall hereafter be known as the
14	Board of Correctional Education. The supervision of the Department shall be vested in the Board of
15	Correctional Education. The Board shall be composed of seven members who shall be appointed by the
16	Governor, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly. In making appointments, the Governor shall
17	endeavor to select appointees of such qualifications and experience necessary to ensure that membership
18	of the Board includes persons suitably qualified to consider and act upon the various matters under the
19	Board's jurisdiction. These appointees shall include one educator with experience working in special
20	education as defined in § 22.1-213, two educators with experience working with specific learning
21	disabilities as defined in § 22.1-213, one elected official, and one citizen with an immediate family
22 23	<i>member incarcerated within the Commonwealth.</i> Members shall be appointed for terms of four years each except that whenever a vacancy occurs other than by expiration of a term, the Governor shall
23 24	appoint a member for the remainder of that term. No member shall serve more than two consecutive
25	four-year terms. The chairman of the Virginia Parole Board, two persons designated by the Director of
2 6	the Department of Corrections and the Director of Juvenile Justice and the director of Career and
27 27	Technical Education in the Department of Education shall serve as ex officio members without vote.
