HOUSE BILL NO. 971

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the House Committee on Education on January 23, 2006)

(Patrons Prior to Substitute— Delegates Ebbin and Englin [H.B. 391])

A BILL to authorize T.C. Williams High School in Alexandria to be opened before Labor Day in 2006; 7 sunset.

8 Whereas, T.C. Williams High School in Alexandria, Virginia, was opened in 1971 and, at a time of 9 racial turmoil, became famous for the role the Titans football team played in bringing the community 10 together; and

11 Whereas, T.C. Williams continues to serve a uniquely integrated and united community with a diverse student population having many talents and many needs; and Whereas, in 2007, 35-year-old T.C. Williams High School will be replaced with a new 12

13 14 state-of-the-art building designed as a sustainable structure to be user-friendly for high school reform 15 initiatives that is being constructed on the same property as the existing school; and

16 Whereas, beginning with demolition of one wing and a parking lot in December 2004, construction of the new T.C. Williams High School is scheduled to be completed in precise phases that accommodate 17 the continuing and safe operation of the present school until the summer of 2007 when the old school 18 will be demolished and final construction, clean-up, and relocation to the new high school will be 19 20 completed; and

21 Whereas, § 22.1-79.1 of the Code of Virginia requires local school boards to set the school calendar 22 so that the first day students are required to attend school will be after Labor Day, with waivers 23 authorized by the Board of Education under narrow circumstances that do not address school 24 construction: and

Whereas, a smooth, seamless, and safe relocation of the T.C. Williams students and programs to the 25 26 new high school by the fall of 2007 will require that the old T.C. Williams High School begin its first 27 day of the 2006-2007 school year prior to Labor Day 2006 in order to close its doors forever by the end 28 of May 2007; now, therefore, 29

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1.§ 1. Opening of the 2006 school year at T.C. Williams High School in Alexandria.

Notwithstanding the provisions of § 22.1-79.1, the School Board of the City of Alexandria may set 31 the 2006-2007 school calendar for the old T.C. Williams High School so that the first day students are required to attend the old T.C. Williams High School for the 2006-2007 school year shall be prior to 32 33 34 Labor Day of 2006 and the last day students shall be required to attend the old T.C. Williams High 35 Schools shall be at the end of May 2007.

In setting its 2006-2007 school calendar for all other Alexandria schools, the School Board of the 36

37 City of Alexandria shall comply with the provisions of § 22.1-79.1.

38 2. That the provisions of this act shall expire on January 1, 2007.
