| 8 | WHEREAS, Stafford M. "Buck" Pace was a lifelong resident of Fluvanna County and a dedicated |
| 9 | public servant; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, a member of the Fluvanna County Board of Supervisors representing the Palmyra |
| 11 | District for eight years, Buck Pace served as vice-chairman of the board from 1997 to 1999 and again |
| 12 | from 2001 to 2002; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, committed to improving the quality of life for the citizens of Fluvanna County, Buck |
| 14 | Pace supported economic development that would provide good jobs and a lower residential tax burden, |
| 15 | but he was also a staunch advocate of property rights; and |
| 16 | WHEREAS, Buck Pace was an invaluable proponent of the installation of water and sewer |
| 17 | infrastructure in the county; and |
| 18 | WHEREAS, Buck Pace strongly supported bringing the Tenaska Virginia Generating Station, an |
| 19 | 885-megawatt natural gas-fired, combined-cycle electric generation facility, to Fluvanna County and was |
| 20 | instrumental in negotiations that resulted in Tenaska, Inc., contributing to open space, public safety, and |
| 21 | infrastructure planning in the county; and |
| 22 | WHEREAS, a great mentor to young people, Buck Pace was an avid supporter of local youth |
| 23 | athletic programs; and |
| 24 | WHEREAS, Buck Pace will be missed by his family, his numerous friends and colleagues, and the |
| 25 | citizens of Fluvanna County; now, therefore, be it |
| 26 | RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly mourn |
| 27 | the passing of an outstanding public servant and fine Virginian, Stafford M. Pace; and, be it |
