10	WHEREAS, the State Board of Elections conducted a review of the Campaign Finance Disclosure
11	Act (the Act) during the 2005 interim pursuant to House Joint Resolution 667 (2005) and, with the
12	assistance of a special subcommittee, proposed a revised version of the Act; and
13	WHEREAS, the Board and subcommittee propose to continue this review to address several complex
14	issues that involve possibly substantive changes in the Act; now, therefore, be it
15	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the State Board of Elections be
16	encouraged to continue its review of the Campaign Finance Disclosure Act to address issues that require
17	further evaluation, including registration and reporting requirements for federal committees and
18	out-of-state and multi-state committees, the "express advocacy" standard, and the treatment of certain
19	tax-exempt or similar organizations; and, be it
20	RESOLVED FURTHER, That the State Board of Elections be encouraged during its review to seek
21	once again the advice of two members of the House Committee on Privileges and Elections and two
22	members of the Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections as may be designated by their respective
23	chairs, one representative each from the Democratic and Republican Parties of Virginia, two treasurers
24	representing political committees that are registered with the State Board two general registrars and one

representing political committees that are registered with the State Board, two general registrars, and oneor more non-profit groups with an interest in Campaign Finance disclosure in Virginia.
