   became a SEAL; and
- WHEREAS, Michael M. McGreevy, became a SEAL in 2000 after graduating from Basic
   Underwater Demolition/SEAL training as "Honor Man" of class 230 at Naval Special Warfare Center,
   Coronado, California; and
- WHEREAS, Michael M. McGreevy distinguished himself as a Navy SEAL earning multiple
  decorations during his Navy career, including the Bronze Star (with "V" for Valor), Purple Heart, Navy
  and Marine Corps Commendation Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (3 awards),
  Combat Action Ribbon, Meritorious Unit Commendation, National Defense Service Medal (2 awards),
  Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism
