HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 41

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE (Proposed by the House Committee on Privileges and Elections

on January 11, 2006)

(Patrons Prior to Substitute—Delegates Marshall, R.G. and Cosgrove [HJR 23])

Proposing an amendment to Article I of the Constitution of Virginia by adding a section numbered 15-A, relating to marriage.

8 WHEREAS, a proposed amendment to the Constitution of Virginia, hereinafter set forth, was agreed
9 to by a majority of the members elected to each of the two houses of the General Assembly at the
10 regular session of 2005 and referred to this, the next regular session held after the 2005 general election
11 of members of the House of Delegates, as required by the Constitution of Virginia; now, therefore, be it
12 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the following amendment to the
13 Constitution of Virginia be, and the same hereby is, proposed in conformity with the provisions of
14 Section 1 of Article XII of the Constitution of Virginia, namely:

15 Amend Article I of the Constitution of Virginia by adding a section numbered 15-A as follows:

ARTIČLE I

BILL OF RIGHTS

18 Section 15-A. Marriage.

19 That only a union between one man and one woman may be a marriage valid in or recognized by20 this Commonwealth and its political subdivisions.

21 This Commonwealth and its political subdivisions shall not create or recognize a legal status for

22 relationships of unmarried individuals that intends to approximate the design, qualities, significance, or 23 effects of marriage. Nor shall this Commonwealth or its political subdivisions create or recognize

effects of marriage. Nor shall this Commonwealth or its political subdivisions create or recognize
 another union, partnership, or other legal status to which is assigned the rights, benefits, obligations,
 qualities, or effects of marriage.
