WHEREAS, citizens of the community have supported Amherst County High School by providing numerous upgrades, improvements, and additions to the physical facilities; and

WHEREAS, Amherst County High School students have excelled in both academics and athletics through the course of its 50-year history, and the faculty and staff have been a source of inspiration and guidance to generations of students; and

WHEREAS, Amherst County High School is currently celebrating its 50th anniversary with events and commemorations throughout the school year; and

WHEREAS, Amherst County High School students, faculty, staff, parents, and alumni look forward with eager anticipation to the on-going contributions that the school system will make to future generations of Amherst County residents; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly commend the students, faculty, staff, parents, and alumni of Amherst County High School and the surrounding community on reaching this milestone in the school's history; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution for presentation to Amherst County High School as an expression of the General Assembly's congratulations and best wishes for the future.
