10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 63.2-505.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 63.2-505.2. Eligibility for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families or food stamps; drug-related
13	felonies.
14	A person who is otherwise eligible to receive <i>Temporary Assistance for Needy Families or</i> food
15	stamp benefits shall be exempt from the application of section 115(a) of the Personal Responsibility and
16	Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996, P.L. 104-193, and shall not be denied such assistance
17	solely because he has been convicted of a felony offense of possession of a controlled substance in
1/	solely because he has been convicted of a reiony offense of possession of a controlled substance in

18 violation of § 18.2-250, provided such person is complying with, or has already complied with, all
19 obligations imposed by the criminal court, is actively engaged in or has completed a substance abuse
20 treatment program, participates in periodic drug screenings, and any other obligations as determined by

21 the Department.
