6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-59 of the Code of Virginia, relating to extorting money, etc. by
7	threats; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 18.2-59 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 18.2-59. Extorting money, etc., by threats.
11	If any person threaten injury to the character, person, or property of another person or accuse him of
12	any offense or threaten to report him as being illegally present in the United States and thereby extort
13	money, property, or pecuniary benefit or any note, bond, or other evidence of debt from him or any
14	other person, he shall be guilty of a Class 5 felony.
15	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
16	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot
17	be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for
18	periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
