10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 46.2-341.16 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 46.2-341.16. Vehicle classifications and endorsements.
13 14	A. A commercial driver's license shall authorize the licensee to operate only the classes and types of commercial motor vehicles designated thereon. The classes of commercial motor vehicles for which such
14	license may be issued are:
16	1. Class A-Combination heavy vehicle Any combination of vehicles with a gross combination
17	weight rating of 26,001 or more pounds, provided the gross vehicle weight rating of the vehicles being
18	towed is in excess of 10,000 pounds;
19	2. Class B-Heavy straight vehicle or other combination Any single motor vehicle with a gross
20	vehicle weight rating of 26,001 or more pounds, or any such vehicle towing a vehicle with a gross
21	vehicle weight rating that is not in excess of 10,000 pounds; and
22 23	3. Class C-Small vehicle Any vehicle that does not fit the definition of a Class A or Class B vehicle and is either (i) designed to transport sixteen or more passengers including the driver or (ii) is
23 24	used in the transportation of hazardous materials.
25	B. Commercial driver's licenses shall be issued with endorsements and restrictions authorizing the
26	driver to operate or restricting the driver to the types of vehicles identified as follows:
27	1. Type T-Vehicles with double or triple trailers;
28	2. Type P-Vehicles carrying passengers;
29 30	 Type N-Vehicles with cargo tanks; Type H-Vehicles required to be placarded for hazardous materials; and
30 31	5. Type K-Vehicles not equipped with air brakes-; and
32	6. Type S-School buses carrying 16 or more passengers, including the driver.
33	C. Persons authorized to drive Class A vehicles are also authorized to drive Classes B and C
34	vehicles, provided such persons possess the requisite endorsements for the type of vehicle driven.
35	D. Persons authorized to drive Class B vehicles are also authorized to drive Class C vehicles,
36 37	provided such persons possess the requisite endorsements for the type of vehicle driven. E. Any licensee who seeks to add a classification or endorsement to his commercial driver's license
37 38	must submit the application forms, certifications and other updated information required by the
	Department and shall take and successfully complete the tests required for such classification or
