12	1. That § 18.2-174 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of
13	Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-174.2 as follows:
14	§ 18.2-174. Impersonating law-enforcement officer; penalty.
15	Any person who shall falsely assume or exercise assumes or exercises the functions, powers, duties
16	and privileges incident to the office of sheriff, police officer, marshal, or other <i>law-enforcement or</i> peace
17	officer, or who shall falsely assume or pretend assumes or pretends to be any such officer, shall be
18	deemed is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor 6 felony.
19	§ 18.2-174.2. Unlawful representation of vehicle as a law-enforcement vehicle; penalty.
20	Any person who without authority operates a motor vehicle that is not a law-enforcement vehicle
21	with the intent to make another believe that the vehicle is an official law-enforcement vehicle and in a
22	manner that would lead another to reasonably believe that the vehicle is a law-enforcement vehicle is
23	guilty of a Class 6 felony.
24	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
25	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is at

26 least \$384,896 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for
27 periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
