That § 51.1-212 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 51.1-212. Definitions. 11 As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning: 12 13 "Employee" means any (i) member of the Capitol Police Force as described in § 30-34.2:1, (ii) 14 campus police officer appointed under the provisions of Chapter 17 (§ 23-232 et seq.) of Title 23, (iii) 15 game warden in the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries appointed under the provisions of Chapter 16 2 (§ 29.1-200 et seq.) of Title 29.1, (iv) special agent of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control appointed under the provisions of Chapter 1 (§ 4.1-100 et seq.), (v) law-enforcement officer employed 17 by the Virginia Marine Resources Commission as described in § 9.1-101, (vi) correctional officer as the 18 term is defined in § 53.1-1, and including correctional officers employed at a juvenile correction facility 19 20 as the term is defined in § 66-25.3, (vii) any parole officer appointed pursuant to § 53.1-143, and (viii) any commercial vehicle enforcement officer employed by the Department of State Police, and (ix) 21 22 conservation officer of the Department of Conservation and Recreation appointed pursuant to 23 § 10.1-115. 24 "Member" means any person included in the membership of the Retirement System as provided in 25 this chapter. 26 "Normal retirement date" means a member's sixtieth birthday. 27 "Retirement System" means the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System. 2. That the present value of benefits accrued on behalf of members of the Virginia Retirement 28 29 System (§ 51.1-124.1 et seq. of the Code of Virginia) who become members of the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System (§ 51.1-211 et seq. of the Code of Virginia) on the effective date of 30 this act shall be transferred from the assets of the Virginia Retirement System to the Virginia Law 31 Officers' Retirement System. 32 33 3. That any conservation officer of the Department of Conservation and Recreation appointed pursuant to § 10.1-115 of the Code of Virginia who becomes a member of the Virginia Law 34 35 Officers' Retirement System on or after July 1, 2006, shall be eligible only for those retirement 36 benefits under such system that are provided to employees who commence employment or 37 reemployment on or after July 1, 2001. 4. That the provisions of this act shall not increase, decrease, or affect in any way the retirement 38 39 allowance or retirement benefit of any person who retired prior to July 1, 2006, under any 40 retirement system administered by the Virginia Retirement System.
