VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact § 2.2-720 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Alzheimer's Disease and 3 Related Disorders Commission.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6 7

1. That § 2.2-720 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 § 2.2-720. (Expires July 1, 2006) Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders Commission.

9 A. The Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders Commission (Commission) is established as an 10 advisory commission in the executive branch of state government. The purpose of the entity is to assist people with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders and their caregivers. 11

B. The Commission shall consist of 15 nonlegislative citizen members. Members shall be appointed 12 13 as follows: three members to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates; two members to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules; and 10 members to be appointed by the Governor, of 14 15 whom seven shall be from among the boards, staffs, and volunteers of the Virginia chapters of the 16 Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders Association and three shall be from the public at large.

17 After the initial staggering of terms, nonlegislative citizen members shall be appointed for a term of four years. Appointments to fill vacancies, other than by expiration of a term, shall be for the unexpired 18 19 terms. All members may be reappointed. However, no nonlegislative citizen member shall serve more 20 than two consecutive four-year terms. The remainder of any term to which a member is appointed to fill 21 a vacancy shall not constitute a term in determining the member's eligibility for reappointment. 22 Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments.

23 The Commission shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its membership. A majority 24 of the voting members shall constitute a quorum. The Commission shall meet at least four times each 25 year. The meetings of the Commission shall be held at the call of the chairman or whenever the 26 majority of the voting members so request.

27 C. Members shall receive such compensation for the discharge of their duties as provided in 28 § 2.2-2813. All members shall be reimbursed for reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the 29 performance of their duties as provided in §§ 2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825. Funding for the costs of 30 compensation and expenses of the members shall be provided by the Department for the Aging. 31

D. The Commission shall have the following powers and duties:

32 1. Examine the needs of persons with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders, as well as the needs 33 of their caregivers, and ways that state government can most effectively and efficiently assist in meeting 34 those needs;

35 2. Advise the Governor and General Assembly on policy, funding, regulatory and other issues related to persons suffering from Alzheimer's disease and related disorders and their caregivers; 36

37 3. Develop the Commonwealth's plan for meeting the needs of patients with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders and their caregivers, and advocate for such plan; 38

39 4. Submit a report, including an executive summary, by October 1 of each year to the Governor and 40 General Assembly regarding the activities and recommendations of the Commission; and

41 5. Establish priorities for programs among state agencies related to Alzheimer's disease and related 42 disorders and criteria to evaluate these programs.

43 E. The Department for the Aging shall provide staff support to the Commission. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Commission, upon request. 44

F. The Commission may apply for and expend such grants, gifts or bequests from any source as may 45 become available in connection with its duties under this section, and may comply with such conditions 46 47 and requirements as may be imposed in connections therewith.

G. This section shall expire on July 1, 2006 2009. 48
