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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 33.1-391.5 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 33.1-391.5. Responsibilities of Department.
13	The Department shall have the following responsibilities:
14	1. Determine present and future needs for, and economic feasibility of providing, public
15	transportation, transportation demand management, and ridesharing facilities and services and the
16 17	retention, improvement, and addition of passenger and freight rail transportation in the Commonwealth; 2. Formulate and implement plans and programs for the establishment, improvement, development
18	and coordination of public transportation, transportation demand management, and ridesharing facilities
19	and services, and the retention and improvement of passenger and freight rail transportation services and
20	corridors in the Commonwealth, and coordinate transportation demand management and innovative
<b>2</b> 1	technological transportation initiatives with the Department of Transportation;
22	3. Coordinate with the Department of Transportation in the conduct of research, policy analysis, and
$\overline{23}$	planning for the rail and public transportation modes as may be appropriate to ensure the provision of
24	effective, safe, and efficient public transportation and passenger and freight rail services in the
25	Commonwealth;
26	4. Develop uniform financial and operating data on and criteria for evaluating all public
27	transportation activities in the Commonwealth, develop specific methodologies for the collection of such
28	data by public transit operators, regularly and systematically verify such data by means of financial
29	audits and periodic field reviews of operating data collection methodologies, and develop such other
30	information as may be required to evaluate the performance and improve the economy or efficiency of
31	public transit or passenger and freight rail operations, transportation demand management programs, and
32	ridesharing in the Commonwealth;
33 24	5. Provide training and other technical support services to transportation operators and ridesharing coordinators as may be appropriate to improve public transportation, ridesharing, and passenger and

33 36	6. Maintain liaison with state, local, district and federal agencies or other entities, private and public,
37	having responsibilities for passenger and freight rail, transportation demand management, ridesharing,
38	and public transportation programs;
<b>39</b>	7. Receive, administer and allocate all planning, operating, capital, and any other grant programs
40	from the Federal Transit Administration, the Federal Railroad Administration, the Federal Highway
41	Administration, and other agencies of the United States government for public transportation, passenger
42	and freight rail transportation, transportation demand management, and ridesharing purposes with
43	approval of the Board and to comply with all conditions attendant thereto;
44	8. Administer all state grants for public transportation, rail transportation, ridesharing, and
45	transportation demand management purposes with approval of the Board;

50 51	committees, task forces, and other entities, public and private, having responsibility for passenger and fraight rail transportation demand management ridesharing and public transportation:

52 53	11. Represent the Commonwealth's interests in passenger and freight rail, transportation demand management, ridesharing, and public transportation and coordinate with the Department of

58	inspections and rail regulations which fall within its purview;

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13. Prepare and review state legislation and Commonwealth recommendations on federal legislation and regulations as directed by the Secretary of Transportation; and
14. Promote public transportation, ridesharing, and passenger and freight rail safety; and
15. Provide sufficient state matching funds for the federal FTA Section 5311 Rural Public Transportation program to guarantee that the local match required by the program does not exceed 62 63 64 25%.
