59 Any member who retires and later returns to covered employment shall not be entitled to select a60 different retirement option for a subsequent retirement.

61 2. Active members of the General Assembly who are eligible to receive a retirement allowance under 62 this title, excluding their service as a member of the General Assembly, shall be eligible to receive a 63 retirement allowance based on their creditable service and average final compensation for service other 64 than as a member of the General Assembly. Such members of the General Assembly shall continue to 65 be reported as any other members of the retirement system. Upon ceasing to serve in the General Assembly, members of the General Assembly receiving a retirement allowance based on their creditable 66 service and average final compensation for service other than as a member of the General Assembly 67 shall have their retirement allowance recomputed prospectively to include their service as a member of 68 the General Assembly. Active members of the General Assembly shall be prohibited from receiving a 69 service retirement allowance under this title based solely on their service as a member of the General 70 71 Assembly.

3. (Expires July 1, 2010) Any person receiving a service retirement allowance under this chapter,
who is hired as a local school board instructional or administrative employee required to be licensed by
the Board of Education, may elect to continue to receive the retirement allowance during such
employment, under the following conditions:

76 (a) The person's retirement allowance is based in whole or in part on service as a local school board
 77 instructional or administrative employee required to be licensed by the Board of Education;

(ba) The person has been receiving such retirement allowance for a certain period of time preceding
 his employment as provided by law;

(eb) The person is not receiving a retirement benefit pursuant to an early retirement incentive
 program from any local school division within the Commonwealth; and

(dc) At the time the person is employed, the position to which he is assigned is among those
identified by the Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to subdivision 4 of § 22.1-23, by the
relevant division superintendent, pursuant to § 22.1-70.3, or by the relevant local school board, pursuant to subdivision 9 of § 22.1-79.

86 If the person elects to continue to receive the retirement allowance during the period of such
87 employment, then his service performed and compensation received during such period of time will not
88 increase, decrease, or affect in any way his retirement benefits before, during, or after such employment.
