WHEREAS, Harry Lumsden served as the Louisa County treasurer for many years and was a member of the Virginia Treasurers' Association; and

WHEREAS, committed to the well-being of his neighbors, Harry Lumsden was active in the community and a member of the Mineral Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, dedicated to his fellow veterans and their concerns, Harry Lumsden was a loyal member of the Masonic Day Lodge #58, the VFW Post 8947, the American Legion Post 116, and the Sons of the Confederate Veterans; and

WHEREAS, Harry Lumsden was a longtime, devoted member and elder emeritus of Louisa Christian Church; and
