WHEREAS, with her breadth of knowledge, personal and professional integrity, and compassionate
spirit, Katherine Morrison was a natural to spearhead innovative programming that improved the quality
of life for all Alexandrians regardless of age, race, or socioeconomic background; and

WHEREAS, Katherine Morrison was invaluable in implementing vital new programs such as Early
 Head Start, 21st Century Community Learning Center, and Building Better Futures, which were added
 to help children develop the skills that lead to successful, self-sufficient adulthood; and

WHEREAS, Katherine Morrison's personal warmth and caring for others is well-known, and she is
 highly respected by her peers and much beloved by her employees and, perhaps most importantly, by
 the many families she has served; and

WHEREAS, Katherine Morrison's extraordinary contributions to The Campagna Center are indelibly
 etched in the history of its programs and the future well-being of the citizens of the City of Alexandria;
 now, therefore, be it
