4. Title Voice-over-Internet protocol service; E-911 notice.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Voice-over-Internet protocol service; E-911 notice. Eliminates the jurisdiction of the State Corporation Commission to regulate voice-over-Internet protocol service. Voice-over-Internet protocol service is excluded from the scope of the definitions of telephone service, telecommunications service, local exchange telephone service, and interexchange telephone service. Voice-over-Internet protocol service includes any Internet protocol enabled service utilizing a broadband connection. Providers of voice-over-Internet protocol service or wireless telecommunications service that do not include enhanced 911 service are required to notify their affected subscribers of the absence of E-911 service. Consumers of voice-over-Internet protocol service will be subject to the special local tax for enhanced 911 service. Providers of voice-over-Internet protocol service are required to provide the State Corporation Commission and Wireless E-911 Services Board with a plan for how they propose to develop and implement the capability for Voice-over-Internet protocol service users to have enhanced 9-1-1 service and a timetable for its anticipation completion.
